Dress Code

All dance class students are required to wear a leotard and tights to each class.

Unless otherwise specified for class, hair must be completely out of the face. A bun is required for ballet.

Proper shoes are required for each class:

Ballet: Pink ballet slippers with elastic.

Jazz: Tan jazz shoes, slip-on jazz boots are preferred, but laced shoes are acceptable. Black jazz boots may be required depending on recital costume.

Modern: Bare feet, dance paws, foot undees, etc. For younger students, lyrical strap shoes are permitted, though other shoes may be required for performances.

Tap: Younger students may wear mary jane style tap shoes, but ribbons should always be double knotted. Older students should wear black oxford tap shoes.

Pointe: Pointe shoe requirements will be discussed the first week of class.

Hip-Hop and Breakdancing: Black dance sneakers or tennis shoes. Any shoes with laces should be double knotted for class or performance. Shoes must be dedicated for dance class use only. Students with dirty sneakers or shoes will not be admitted to class.

Fitness Class: Students are expected to dress in appropriate, non-revealing, workout attire. Shoes must be dedicated for fitness class use only. Students with dirty sneakers or shoes will not be admitted to class.

B&B Dance Company reserves the right to ask any student in any class that is not dressed appropriately to leave the premises.

Other Required Fees

- Holiday Show and Recital Fee: \$60 per family (**\$20 due December 1st**, **\$40 due May 1st**)
- Costume Fee: \$65 per student per single form class, \$75 per student per combination class, required of all students. Note, this does not include special order costumers for solos, duets, competition dances, etc. Students will be responsible for the full cost of these types of costumes plus any additional fees, such as shipping and ordering surcharges. (**Due November 1st**)
- Each family will receive two tickets for the June recital. The price of additional tickets may vary but will likely be around \$10 a ticket.

Private Lessons and Other Rates *(rates and due dates may vary, typical are shown)*

- ½ Hour: \$34 *(due when lesson is provided)*
- 1 Hour: \$65 *(due when lesson is provided)*
- Dance Team Solo: \$120 per dance *(due when 1st lesson is provided)*
- Dance Team Duet, Trio, etc.: \$60 per dancer per dance *(due when 1st lesson is provided)*
- Fitness Punch Card: 5 class - \$35, 10 class - \$65
- Fitness Drop In: \$8 *(due at the time of the class)*

Discounts**

- Family Discount: 25% off the tuition of each family member after the first. Does not apply to fitness classes, private lessons, and solo and duet sessions.
- Pay tuition for the entire session (all ten months, August through June) in full at the time of registration and receive a 5% discount.
- Referral: Refer a friend and receive 50% or \$50, whichever is less, off of one month's tuition for one family member. Family members are not eligible as referrals. The person referred must register and enroll in at least one class prior to April 1st 2012 and must remain enrolled for at least two consecutive months and must have paid all tuition and other required fees for those two months.

*** Discounts may vary based on current promotions; however, they will not be less than shown above.*

Late Payment and Cancellation Fees

- Returned Check or Payment: \$20
- Late Payment (after 10th of the month): \$5, (after the 20th of the month): \$10, (after the last day of the month): \$20
- Those that cancel a private session with less than 24 hour of advance notice will be charged a \$10 fee. Those that fail to provide notice of cancellation will be charged for the entire amount of the scheduled lesson.

All Prices subject to change at the discretion of B&B Dance Company. The pricing in effect at the time a student is registered will be locked in for that student for the entire 2011/2012 session.

B&B Dance Company General Policies

(Issued 7/24/2011)



Registration, Tuition, and Fees

1. Registration and Enrollment

- a. The registration of a student signifies the assumption of definitive obligations between the student and the B&B Dance Company. It is an agreement by the student to fulfill the terms of the registration contract.
- b. By registering for a class the student is committing to making a reasonable effort to remain enrolled in that class for the duration, or the remaining duration, of the class session. In return B&B Dance Company will continue to reserve a spot for the student in the class.
- c. All tuition, fees, assessments, and deposits must be paid by the specified registration or enrollment date and in accordance with the tuition and fee schedule.
- d. Registration and enrollment is not complete until tuition and fees are paid in accordance with this policy and the tuition and fee schedule, B&B Dance Company has confirmed acceptance of the student into the desired classes, and all required documentation has been signed and received by B&B Dance Company.
- e. Class sessions typically run from:
 - i. Standard session: August through June of the following year (10 months)
 - ii. Summer session: Late June or early July through August or early September (2 months)

2. Tuition and Fees

- a. Payment Policy
 - i. Tuition will be assessed on a monthly basis for the duration, or the remaining duration, of the class session in which the student is enrolled.
 - ii. Tuition is due on the first day of each month of the class session starting with the first month in which the student will begin attending classes.
 - iii. Tuition for the current month will be due immediately for students registering and enrolling after the first of the month if the student intends to attend classes in that month.
 - iv. Monthly assessment of tuition is a payment plan. It is not correlated to the number of days, the number of classes offered, or the number of weeks during which class is held in a given month.
 - v. Students, at their discretion, may pay the full tuition amount, or the remaining full tuition amount, for the entire class session at any time.
 - vi. Recital fees, costume dues, and all other dues and fees will be assessed in accordance with the tuition and fees schedule.
- b. Late Payment and Returned Checks
 - i. A late fee, for an amount outlined in the tuition and fees schedule, will be applied if payment is not received within ten days of the payment due date. This applies to all tuition, dues, and fees.
 - ii. **Students with accounts that are more than one month overdue will not be allowed to attend class until the outstanding amount is paid or an alternative payment plan is arranged with B&B Dance Company.**
 - iii. Returned checks will be assessed a fee as outlined in the tuition and fees schedule.
- c. Refunds and Withdrawal
 - i. If a student withdraws from a class then notice must be provided to B&B Dance Company prior to the first of the month immediately following the month in which the student withdrawal occurred. If notice of the student's withdrawal is not provided to B&B Dance Company the student's account will continue to be assessed all applicable fees and dues per the tuition and fees schedule.
 - ii. Refunds will not be issued for a month paid by the student if the withdrawal occurs after the twentieth day of the month paid by the student. Refunds for withdrawal after the first of the month will be prorated.
 - iii. All unpaid tuition, fees, and dues must be paid in full at the time of withdrawal.
 - iv. B&B Dance Company cannot issue refunds for costumes once they have been ordered. Students will be given their costumes whether or not they participate in the event.

Classes and Recital

3. Classes
 - a. Generally, classes are held on a weekly basis per the class schedule. This may vary depending on the nature of the class. For example, private lessons may be scheduled on a less formal basis.
 - b. Regular attendance is important in aiding students' progress as well as completing class choreography. Class begins on time and students are expected to arrive early enough to prepare for class.
 - c. Students are welcome to make up a missed class the same or the following week by attending a similar class in which they are not currently enrolled.
 - d. B&B Dance Company makes every attempt to follow the same major holiday schedule as the Brighton 27j School District (Thanksgiving, Winter Break, Spring Break, etc.). There may however be deviations and teacher work days or minor holidays are generally not observed by B&B Dance Company.
 - e. For inclement weather updates please see the B&B Dance Company website or call for details.
4. Recital
 - a. All students enrolled in one or more classes in the August-June session are required to participate in the holiday show and annual recital, regardless of when they enrolled.
 - b. **Video or sound recording of the actual recital and holiday show performances, by any mechanism, is strictly prohibited.** Video recording during a show is a violation of copyright law and may create a safety hazard for the dancers on stage. Those found to be video or sound recording during the performance will be asked to stop and may be asked to leave the show.
 - c. **Flash photography during the actual recital and holiday show performance is strictly prohibited.** The use of flash photography may create a safety hazard for the dancers on stage. Those found to be using flash photography during the performance will be asked to stop and may be asked to leave the show.

Student and Studio Behavior

5. **Class is for dancers only. Please do not interrupt class.** If you need to speak with an instructor please see them before or after class. Please keep younger children from disturbing class.
6. Students are responsible for their own belongings. Please write your name in all shoes, costumes, clothing, and other belongings. B&B Dance Company does keep lost and found items for several months.
7. Students must remain in the lobby until a parent or guardian has arrived to pick them up. Students are not permitted to wait or play in the parking lots or street area, other areas of the studio (such as the office, closets, etc.).
8. Smoking and alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the studio. No person that appears to be under the influence of either drugs or alcohol will be admitted.
9. Food and drinks are permitted in the lobby area only. Water bottles are permitted in classrooms.
10. Students are required to follow the dress code (including hair and shoes) for the style of class in which they are enrolled.
11. Students and Parents are responsible for picking up after themselves. This includes: placing trash, empty or partially empty water bottles, food, etc. in the proper waste receptacles and putting toys, magazines, and the like back in their proper place.

Policy Change
